

Scholarships / Tuition Exchange

In lieu of a cash payment, the tuition exchange program allows students to use the following methods as trade/exchange your tuition. While this is not a legally binding agreement/contract, we will lay out the terms that are agreed upon and file this in your student file for reference. Both student and the teacher will act in good faith and make reasonable efforts to meet the agreements below. If either the school or the student has to change the terms listed, we will know it was with pure intention.

\$3,060 total or \$494 x 6 sessions - Students can use any combination of 3 (then case by case after that).

Studio Work Exchange, Teach - up to 10 classes (valued at \$49.40 per hour)

This can be in a class on the schedule or as a substitute for another teacher. The lead trainer will release the student to begin teaching group classes.

Community Volunteer Exchange - up to 10 hours (valued at \$49.40 per hour)

Students will have the option to offer their assistance to organizations throughout Wise County on a volunteer basis. Hours spent volunteering (act of serva) will count towards your tuition.

Studio Work Exchange, Admin - up to 10 hours (valued at \$49.40 per hour)

Students will have the option to work at the studio or at home for administrative support. This would include light admin areas such as social media, email marketing, return phone calls, reviewing schedules. This can be done at any time during the program.

Private Scholarship, 2 page essay or any artistic piece (\$400 towards tuition)

Students can submit an essay or any form of art that demonstrates either of the topics listed below. This can be done prior to completion of the program. Student submission and reward is private.

Public Scholarship, 2 page essay or any artistic piece (\$500 towards tuition)

Students can submit an essay or any form of art that demonstrates either of the topics listed below. This can be done prior to completion of the program. Some companies will want to display your work publicly. To receive this award, you would have to consent to them sharing it with the public if they decide to.
